

It is expected that the final plan will be approved by the FSC International Board at the end of 2020.

The FSC Global Strategic Plan was approved by the FSC International Board of Directors – and released in October

2015. The process included extensive consultation with FSC members, staff and stakeholders. Click here to access the FSC Global Strategic Plan 2015-2020

All submitted motions for the 2017 FSC General Assembly in Vancouver reported their alignment with the FSC Global Strategic Plan 2015-2020.

The FSC International Board decided to initiate the update of the Global Strategic Plan as part of the preparation process towards the 2020 General Assembly – to make it an effective six-year cycle as specified in motion 84/2014. In addition, the board mandated the Board Strategic Planning Committee (BSPC) to design a process for 2019 and 2020 to enable an advanced version of the updated Global Strategic Plan to be presented and discussed by the full

membership at the 2020 General Assembly. The first draft of the updated Global Strategic Plan (2021–2026) was refined by the Board and sent in public consultation.

In light of the COVID-19 crisis and the postponement of the FSC General Assembly until 2021, the FSC International Board decided that the process to Update the Global Strategy 2021-2026 will include further spaces for membership discussion and engagement.

The results are being used to develop a second draft, expected to go for public consultation in September 2020.

Main Inputs to the Process



The input process has included expert advice to the FSC Board Strategic Planning Committee (BSPC) from an external advisory group of experts and from the Boston Consulting Group, as well as an evaluation of the lessons learned from the Global Strategic Plan (2015–2020).

In September 2019, the Board gathered for a strategy retreat in Cancún, where a high-level theory-of-change exercise was conducted to further align the updated Global Strategic Plan with the level of ambition established in the 2050 Beacon.

The process has also included engagement with the membership through the regional members' meetings and the solutions forums.

1. GSP 2015-2020 Evaluation and Lessons Learned

Main inputs to the process: First Public Consultation




The first public consultation for the first draft of the Global Strategic Plan 2021-2026 was carried out from 18 December 2019 to 26 February 2020. In terms of participation, 151 inputs were collected, 98 of which were from FSC international members. Overall, the first draft of the Global Strategy 2021-2016 was positively received by the stakeholders who participated in the consultation. Based on the results of the first public consultation, the board can now take this process a step further to the next version of this document.


